VOTING ABSENTEE?

Reasons to vote absentee.....

- You are outside the county during early voting and on Election Day—must give address outside county to mail ballot
- You are a student or spouse of a student outside the county during early voting and on Election Day
- You are on the permanent absentee voting register
- You are hospitalized, ill or physically disabled
- You are a caretaker of hospitalized ill or disabled person
- You are a handicapped voter whose poll is inaccessible
- You have jury duty during early voting and on Election Day
- You are 60 years of age or older
- You are a candidate for office
- You are an election day official
- You are out of the county, military or military spouse
- You are observing a religious holiday
- You are a commercial overland truck driver or spouse of an overland truck driver
- You are a nursing home resident and are outside their county of residence
